




efi had more UV-cured printers than any other printer manufacturer at the ISA sign expo.








We know the capable distributor for MultiCam in Bogata, Columbia and see the MultiCam brand at many expos (but we have not yet evaluated their recent models).









Booth of DigiFab; this capable family-owned business has over a decade of professional experience with all aspects of textile inks, fabrics, and printing on textiles.




ATPColor has a major advantage in that this company in Italy has lots of experience with all aspects of textile printing.





There are dozens of distributors at US trade shows, but one we know the best is Graphics One (GO).



Seiko Instruments USA is best known for their colorful mild-solvent ink printers, but now they also offer two models of UV-cured flatbed printers.







